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The Estimate Review Process

In our last newsletter edition, we detailed the estimating process and all that goes into a thorough estimate. The next phase is the detailed review with the client, the architect and the designer.

The Review Phase:

As an estimate considers many specifications and details, it is imperative to review the estimate together at great length to confirm and discuss:

- Are considerations according to client's wishes
- Are all latest changes to the design included
- What design finishes are assumptions vs specified
- What design finishes still have to be selected
- What decisions still have to be made
- What alternative options are available

The in-person review is also an opportunity for the client to meet the extended RCGC Construction team that will be involved in the client's project. It is important for the whole team to get to know each other as the team will work together very closely for several months to come. Clear communication is key on any project and RCGC is BIG on Communication. RCGC utilizes tables and overviews to illustrate more complex information to ensure the communication is as clear as possible. This allows for a better understanding to make decisions and a great reference point during execution.

The Estimate Revision Phase:

Based on all client, architect and designer input and discussion, there is the potential that the estimate must be revised based on additions, changes and clarifications. The time of such an estimate revision can vary based on the scope of the requested changes as we want to be sure to get the estimate as close as possible to the actual cost & timing needed to execute your project to perfection. The client may also visit RCGC's offices and one of our current project sites to become more familiar with RCGC, its team and process.



Second Review with Client & Team:

Upon the revision of the estimate, a second team meeting is necessary to review it. The upfront work for a project of that size cannot be underestimated and should not be rushed as every item that has been decided conclusively, estimated in detail and agreed upon ahead of time will save a lot of time and cost later on.

The Decision Phase:

Upon the final estimate review, the client now has to make the decision who to choose for their project and **should consider many factors in making that decision:**

- Quality of Construction
- Timing of Construction, what start date can the Builder guarantee
- Communication. Communication. Communication.
- It makes or breaks a project. Constant and effective communication from both sides ensure the success of the project.
- **Client Interaction** during the Construction Phase (Construction Portal, Onsite Reviews and Walkthroughs, Record Keeping, etc)
- **Cost** of Construction, have all Builders included all costs and finishes for a true comparison

Thorough planning, clarifications and verifications before project start allow for a smoother, better, faster and more cost efficient construction phase.


